



The Abernethy Enterprise Challenge for Schools – Terms and Conditions

Awards/Prizes

- The winners of *The Merit Award* may use their cash prize to benefit their pupils or their school. They must send at least two publishable photos, and complete a short report which we will issue, to demonstrate how this money has been spent. Abernethy and selected corporate sponsors of the Abernethy Enterprise Challenge for Schools reserve the right to use the photos for any publicity or future publications including all media channels.
- *The Merit Award* prize money must be spent within 12 months of receipt. Photos must be received by Abernethy and the report completed within one month of spending the money.
- If your school would like to use the prize money towards a bigger project which will not be completed within the 12 month time limit then this may be discussed and flexibility may be applied at the discretion of Abernethy.
- *The Young Entrepreneurs Award* prize is a non-residential activity day at Abernethy Nethybridge for up to 30 pupils and 3 teachers/parent helpers. This must be used within 12 months of receipt. No cash alternative is available, and it cannot be used at any other Abernethy centre. If your school would like to book additional pupils on to the activity day or to extend the package to a residential booking, then extras will be paid for in full and prize will be applied as a discount to your overall booking. Dates for the prize booking are subject to availability.
- The judges' decision is final. No correspondence will be entered into. While we appreciate feedback on how we can improve our practices in future, advice will be taken on board at our own discretion and will affect only future cases.
- Abernethy will notify the winners of the prizes and they will also be announced through our media channels. Schools that have not won will be notified by email.

Media/publicity

- All words, photos, film and images submitted in connection with an entry become the property of the Abernethy Trust and can be used for social media and publicity purposes, including possible future publications and those of The Abernethy Enterprise Challenge for Schools corporate sponsors.
- At least 3 usable photos must be sent to complete the challenge.
- Entries should not raise safeguarding issues for any children and young people who might be put at risk by their identity and location entering the public domain.

Money

- All money raised from this challenge must be passed to the Abernethy Trust to enable it to further its charitable work and development.
- A minimum of £15 must be returned to Abernethy even in the unlikely event that no money is raised from the £25 provided.
- If the school are unable to take on the challenge they must return the full £25.

Timings

- The challenge must be completed within five weeks from the stated start date.
- The Completion Form along with the required photos and documents must be sent to us within one week of your challenge ending. If you are sending by post, we will allow 2 days grace for postage.
- You must not begin the challenge with your class before the start date you have stated. You may publicise the upcoming challenge with parents as necessary, but you must not start planning in any way that would cause you an unfair advantage where other schools will be adhering to the five-week window.

- If your challenge is not completed within the five-week period, then you will automatically be excluded from the both awards. Abernethy retains the right to use its own discretion on these terms where any school takes over five weeks and we believe that their circumstances call for leniency to be applied.

Other

- Participating schools must complete a registration form in advance of the seed money being received from Abernethy and a completion form when the challenge is finished.
- All participating schools are fully responsible for their pupils throughout this task. Schools undertake this challenge at their own risk and Abernethy takes no responsibility for the health and safety or legality of participating schools throughout all aspects of this challenge.
- We will not add you to any mailing lists that do not relate to this challenge. Schools may request at any point to be removed from all mailing and notifications about this challenge provided they are not currently taking part or they have completed the challenge in full.
- Abernethy Trust reserves the right to change or add to these terms and conditions at any point without notification.
