

Statement of Faith

We believe in:

1 God as the Creator of all men and the Father of all who believe in the Lord Jesus Christ.

- God created man in His own image (Genesis 1:26 and 27)
- There is an essential difference between the relationship of God to the world in general and to those who believe in the Lord Jesus Christ (John 1:12, John 3:1, 1 John 5:1 and 12)

2 The Lord Jesus Christ, as the one and only Son of God, Redeemer of the world and the one Mediator, through faith in whom alone we obtain forgiveness of sins.

- John 3:16; Romans 3:24; Acts 4:12

3 God, the Holy Spirit who indwells all believers.

- God the Holy Spirit is He who indwells all believers, guides into all truth and glorifies the Lord Jesus Christ. (John 16:7-14; Ephesians 1:13,14)

4 The fact of sin and the necessity for the atonement.

- The fact of universal sin (Romans 3:23; 5:12) and the need for reconciliation (Hebrews 9:22). That reconciliation is the work of the Lord Jesus Christ and of Him alone. (John 1:29; Hebrews 9:26-28; 2 Corinthians 5:18,19)

5 The incarnation, death, resurrection, ascension and coming again of the Lord Jesus Christ.

- The Lord Jesus Christ was the Incarnate Son of God (Matthew 3:17). Born of the Virgin Mary.
- The substitutionary death (2 Corinthians 5:21) of the Lord Jesus Christ is one of the fundamental truths of the Gospel (1 Peter 3:18, Philippians 2:8)
- The resurrection of the Lord Jesus Christ was the cardinal point in apostolic testimony. (1 Corinthians 15:1-4)
- The Lord Jesus Christ ascended into heaven from His group of disciples and was received out of their sight. (Acts 1:9)
- The Lord Jesus Christ will come again bodily and visibly. (Acts 1:11, 1 Thessalonians 4:16)

6 The whole Bible as the inspired Word of God.

- The whole Canon of Scripture as originally given is fully trustworthy and the unerring revelation of God (2 Timothy 3:16, 1 Corinthians 2:13, 2 Peter 1:20-21)
