



## Terms and Conditions for the Abernethy Photographic Competition 2018

### Entry rules

#### To enter

- To enter, email the image to [photos@abernethy.org.uk](mailto:photos@abernethy.org.uk) by the closing date specified within the contest (i.e. the last day of the month).
- Images must be in Scotland.
- The contest is open to all photographers aged 12 or over. If you are under 18, and you have your parent's or legal guardian's consent to participate in the Contest, they are allowed to enter on your behalf. When submitting your entry by email, they must provide your name, age and address on your behalf and their name and contact telephone number as your parent or guardian. We will only use this information in relation to the Contest (including checking your eligibility to enter it) and will not use it for any other purposes whatsoever. We will not keep this information for longer than is necessary for the operation of the Contest.
- The contest is open to all amateur photographers.
- The contest is open to all Abernethy staff members (excluding the Marketing Department) and guests who have attended Abernethy since 1 January 2016. Photos must be taken on or after 1 January 2016.
- The "Abernethy Photographic Competition" is defined as "the contest."

#### Images

- Images should be submitted as jpgs.
- Each jpg should be a maximum of 300dpi and 5MB in file size, with your name and the subject in the title: and a line about why the image is an Abernethy experience with information about where it was taken!
- Maximum 5 entries per person per "Photo of the Month".
- The winner of "Photo of the Month" is allowed to submit more photos the following month.
- Each image can only be entered once and will not be carried over to another month. Duplicates will be removed.

#### Content

- If your submitted image is of a child under 18, you must obtain full parental consent.
- The image must have been created in the past two years (since 1 January 2016) while at an Abernethy Centre or during an Abernethy experience. All images should be of a participant enjoying an Abernethy outdoor or indoor experience, or of a landscape while enjoying an Abernethy experience.
- An Abernethy Centre is defined on or around the grounds of Abernethy Ardeonaig, Abernethy Ardgour, Abernethy Barcaple, Abernethy Nethybridge and Glen Kin.
- You must be the sole author and owner of the copyright of all image entered.
- Source material or proof of permission to use must be made available on request by Abernethy.
- Abernethy does not accept any liability for the publication of unlawfully reproduced images.
- Computer-generated or computer-altered images will not be accepted. Artwork and illustrations will not be accepted.
- Abernethy takes no responsibility for corrupted or late entries.
- By entering your image, you grant Abernethy Trust Ltd the non-exclusive right to reproduce it for any purpose at any time in any media with attribution.
- The winners consent to the use of their image, name and/or photograph in any publicity carried out by Abernethy, without further compensation.

### **Photo of the Month**

- Two winning images will be selected by the Abernethy Marketing Manager and senior members of the Abernethy team, where appropriate for the Photo of the Month.
- These two winning images will be uploaded to the Abernethy Facebook page in a Monthly voting Poll – the winning image is the one with the most likes in the Poll.
- Those voting in this Facebook poll will not be entered in to any kind of prize draw.
- There will be no monthly prize for this monthly winner other than being entered into the quarterly prize draw.
- The quarterly prize is non-transferable.
- Those who have submitted but not won will not be contacted.
- The winner of the “Photo of the Month” will be contacted by email at the start of the following month.
- The winner of the “Photo of the Month” will have their photo added to the Abernethy website as well as Abernethy social media.
- The three winning “Photo of the Month” entries will be sent by the Abernethy Marketing team each quarter to Mark Brigham of Ellis Brigham who will judge the quarterly prize.
- The winner of this quarterly prize will win a £200 voucher from Ellis Brigham.
- The quarterly £200 voucher can be used in store or online. Any postage costs above the £200 will need to be paid by the winner.
- There may be a winner of winners of the first 6 months, voted for in November.
- Photos submitted may be printed and displayed on the Abernethy walls.

### **Dates**

- The first round of entries will run from May, June, July (judged August 2018)
- The second round of entries will run from August, September, October (judged November 2018)
- The third round dates are to be confirmed.

### **And finally!**

- Abernethy’s decision on all matters relating to the competition is final. No correspondence will be entered into.
- Abernethy reserves the right to withhold prizes if, in the opinion of the judges, the quality of entries falls below the standard required.
- You will not be added to a mailing list, other than potential emails around the competition.
