

LEADERSHIP **through** ADVENTURE **Award**

Level 2: Fundamentals Year 11 - 12

Developing the **fundamentals** of leadership, reviewing and team building through a multi-activity adventure programme which can include evening discussion and challenges.

Aims of the Award

This level aims to equip school leavers and senior school pupils with tools to take into further education or the workplace. We aim to develop pupils into more rounded individuals with a wider knowledge of planning, leadership, team work and self awareness.

Who is it for?

Pupils who may be in leadership roles at school, or school prefects. Alternatively, pupils who may be on the margins of education and would benefit from some 'out of classroom' education. This course is a useful stepping stone for those starting to think about their next big challenge.

Whether entering the world of work or further education, understanding the fundamentals of leadership and team work will increase confidence and widen the pupil's world view.



FUNDAMENTALS

What it involves

Included in the multi activity challenge programme will be a review of the basics covering the development of communication and social skills through teamwork and the identification of the value of different reviewing and feedback techniques. We will investigate and refine leadership styles and general team roles as well as "Learning to Learn". We will also start to explore how working as a team can impact on the attitudes, skills and behaviour of other team members. Plenty of adventure in a remote environment...

All pupils will receive an Abernethy Certificate on completion of their visit.
